CLIMATE CRISIS AND ENVIRONMENT

Supports a comprehensive Green New Deal that will provide 100% renewable electricity by 2030.

Supports national ban on fracking. Helped lead fracking bans in Santa Cruz, San Benito, and Monterey Counties.

Supports replacing PG&E and Cal-Am with public utilities. Helped fight for public water on Monterey Peninsula for last 13 years.

Supports transition to sustainable agriculture: Phase out dangerous pesticides and fertilizers that pollute groundwater.

Authored a carbon tax bill that subsidizes factory farms and oil companies and aims for carbon neutrality by 2050.

Refused to take position on Monterey County fracking ban.

Took \$10,000 donation from PG&E in 2018.*

Refuses to take position on public water in Monterey County.

Has accepted over \$340,000 from agribusiness and large food corporations since 2016.*

CORPORATE PAC MONEY

100% funded by people. Takes NO corporate PAC money.

75% of campaign funds come from corporate PACs.

AFFORDABILITY CRISIS

Supports massive increase in Federal Affordable Housing Trust Fund to create permanent affordable housing, full funding of Section 8 rental assistance, and rent control.

Supports Medicare for All / Single-payer universal health care.

Supports tuition-free public college.

Supports tax credits for private developers.

Finally agreed to co-sponsor Medicare for All bill after pressure. Makes no mention of Medicare for All in candidate statement. Accepted over \$90,000 from insurance industry since 2016.*

Position on tuition-free public college unknown.

FOREIGN POLICY AND MILITARY SPENDING

Supports decreasing weapon's budget and diplomacy to phase out nuclear weapons.

Supports new foreign policy and trade agreements to help other countries succeed. Opposes endless wars.

Voted for several bills to increase military budget including 2019 bill that included a \$22 Billion per year increase.

Accepts money from military contractors Lockheed Martin, Honeywell, and Northrop Grumann.*

TAXATION

Supports wealth tax on very rich and repealing GOP tax cuts.

Co-founded For Country caucus with Republicans. Financial support from Amazon CEO Jeff Bezos.
